1 dose, 1 month apart for children less than 9 years getting the vaccine for the first time. One dose to be repeated every year for previously vaccinated children.

To be given to children at high risk of getting pneumococcal disease (in addition to pneumococcal conjugate vaccine)

\*For girls only

The second dose of MMR vaccine can be given at any time 4-8 weeks after the first dose

Note: This immunization schedule has been adapted to ensure that all details of vaccination are recorded. The vaccinating physician is advised to refer to the IFCI guide book and package inserts for details of each vaccine, dosage and catch-up immunization.
